WATER BOTTLES

Scientific research proves the benefits of remaining well hydrated throughout the day by drinking plenty of water. All children are encouraged to keep water bottles on their desks everyday. These must have safety tops—the ones you push up and down—and contain water not juice. Please encourage your child to avail of this.



HEALTHY BREAKS

The canteen contin-

ues to offer a variety of breaktime snacks at a cost of 30p per item, maximum two items. P3-7 pupils bring their snack money daily and are responsible for looking after it

themselves. P1 & 2 pupils

(£2.50/week) should bring snack money in on a Monday in clearly labelled envelopes.

MONEY

Children should not have more money in school than they require for that day.

MEDICATION

If you wish medication to be administered during the school day, you MUST bring the medication to the school secretary, who will give you a form to complete. A copy of the completed form will be sent home with your child. Remember: if your child has a diagnosis of asthma, you MUST provide a blue 'reliever' inhaler to be kept in school. Many thanks to all the parents who have done this already.
