Filling in the Transfer Form

3 sheets – green, white & yellow; write on the <u>top one</u> (GREEN) and the writing will go through onto the other sheet. A **biro** works best with carbon paper.

- Section A is asking for your child's personal details & the school's name etc
- o In <u>Section B</u>, make sure you list **at least 3 schools** and indicate if your child has a brother/sister **currently** attending the school by ticking the box on the right of the line. Answer the **3 questions** at the bottom of this section (if relevant).
- o If your child is currently entitled to **free school meals**, make sure you tick the box near the bottom right of **Section B** and **sign your name** beside it
- When filling in <u>Section C</u>, use your chosen school's Admissions Criteria (<u>www.eani.org.uk/admissions</u> and search for a particular school's admission criteria in its prospectus; you may also request a prospectus from each post-primary school) to give reasons for your choice e.g. brother or sister go to the school; closest post primary school to where you live (ignore AQE / GL scores/grades)
- Make sure you and anyone else with parental responsibility sign Section D

You may wish to delay filling in the Transfer Form until after you have attended the Open Nights at the schools you are considering (dates for Open Nights are on the E.A. website), or you may have already made up your mind and fill it in straight away. Either way, please return it as soon as possible and by <u>Friday 1</u> <u>February</u> at the latest. Thank you.
