WATER BOTTLES

Scientific research proves the benefits of remaining well hydrated throughout the day by drinking plenty of water. All children are encouraged to keep REUSABLE water bottles on their desks everyday. These must be REUSABLE, as we are working to eradicate single-use plastic from the school, and contain water not juice. Please encourage your child to avail of this.

MONEY

MEDICATION

If you wish medication to be administered during the school day, you MUST bring the medication to the school secretary, who will give you a form to complete.
